Arthur Miller's modern social tragedy explores the life and loves of the family of a dock worker in post-war New York.

Eddie Carbone lives with his wife and niece, a happy enough family with an intense love and sense of duty locking them together. But life becomes a struggle for meaning when the family is rocked by the arrival of two illegal immigrant cousins, and tensions mount as an eruption of violence beckons.

With underlying themes of identity, personal politics, sexuality and the law, Miller's tale of ordinary human beings and their extraordinary lives is a richly textured story in keeping with his other plays, *Death of a Salesman*, *The Price* and *All My Sons*.
